Street Smart Forcible Entry

Part of the [When Things Go Bad](#) (WTGB) series, this course is designed to teach street-smart techniques to make forcible entry a simple and more efficient task. Some areas that will be covered include conventional forcible entry, unconventional forcible entry including hasp & staples, slide bolts, chain and padlocks, etc. From door size-up to door removal you will learn many tricks to make your entry a more simple and efficient task. After this course you will be supplied with an arsenal of skills awaiting your next forcible entry. Additionally, burglar bar removal, rotary saw entry, concrete wall breaching, rollup door entry, and other methods will be demonstrated.

REQUIRED TEXT & MATERIALS: Students must provide their own PPE including SCBA. Long pants and closed shoes must be worn on the drill grounds.
