When Things Go Bad: Aggressive Interior Search & Rescue

This course is part of the [When Things Go Bad](#) series and focuses on searching & locating civilians as well as firefighters safely and expeditiously. Multiple strategies for searching, depending on building layout and task at hand will be taught. Such skills as conventional & orientated search, vent-enter search, rope assisted search, large area/team search, and etc. will be covered. Orientation of the searchers will be stressed and tactics for reorientation and other problems that firefighters may encounter will be demonstrated and practiced. In addition, rescue techniques in the IDLH atmosphere will also be covered. Instructors from When Things Go Bad, Inc.

REQUIRED TEXT & MATERIALS: Students must provide their own PPE including SCBA. Long pants and closed shoes must be worn on the drill grounds.
